I need to begin by giving enormous kudos to Sumner Co Charter for proactively getting behind the so-called 'lesser' candidate who dared to defeat the GOP leader. The reports want to focus on the PAC money that helped her win. I believe Miss Rogers will agree that motorcyclists genuinely contributed to this victory effort as well. Way to go Sumner members!

I also need to congratulate our Memphis Wheels of Thunder charter and Preacha. Their every effort to let motorcyclists in District number of voter turn out. I added the total votes for the US Senate 90 know how critically important Representative Deberry is to our efforts and how badly we needed to keep him at the Capitol certainly contributed to victory in his highly contested race.

These two charters are shining examples of what this organization was designed to be: not the next party or club ride but THE grass roots political activist motorcycle organization. With more results like this in the general election, dare I say we should be considered the premiere example to all 50 states?

I appreciate that the wealth of this reading audience are hard-core, devoted voters. This newsletter is targeted to the "git 'er done" bikers of this state. But all of us have heard someone say more than one time "My one vote is not going to make a difference." Well here is your ammunition to challenge those individuals to quit making excuses and be a voice that counts in this general election!

Two primary Incumbents won their bid over a party challenger by a handful of votes; District 71 by 5 votes and District 2 by 11. We lost two of our own Champions to a party newcomer by only 78 votes in one race and 105 in another. We have membership in all of these districts who vote so how could they have made a difference beyond their vote?

The simplest way would be to ask your family members and friends to please vote for your candidate. You could even enjoy a good visit by driving them to their polling station.

But is your charter holding an event between now and elections? With toy runs & pretty days remaining, I can pretty safely venture to say yes. Have you invited a candidate to attend your event or even a charter meeting?

Members of this organization are considered the go-to source for need to know info in our motorcycling community. We are known to be at the pulse of who is up there working for us or against us. This is the most critical resource our membership can contribute to our biker community.

What motorcycle events will be happening this summer in your area of influence? Targeted audiences will not know that they have an important candidate to support if you are not a presence at these events.

How can your state legislative team help you to get this word out? We can ask for an info table at this event. We can have voter registration cards available at that table along with candidate hand bills to remind those bikers to vote for them. We can invite the candidate to attend this event. You have a team at your disposal if only you will request our help!

The campaign for 49 of House seats has already been decided because no opposition candidates filed to run. So there are effectively only 51 seats up for election in the State House this November. It is monumentally important that we be a presence in every one of those districts as well as one third of the open seats in the Senate.

Your legislative team is counting on you to resource these opportunities. Heck, the entire state might be counting on YOUR district. What's more, the time is now! Don't wait for Election Day and here is why:

The early voter turn-out for this August 2nd primary was a record breaker at 326,860. It crushed the prior record by a 50% increase over the 2008 record of 217,441.

The Secretary of State website fails to report the total race and can roughly guess that 617,357 total votes were cast in this primary. That means more than half of those votes were cast early.

Let these numbers encourage your charter and YOU the individual to actively participate in your district's election campaign starting TODAY. Meet your candidates. Get firm position statements on our motorcycle issues. Then take advantage of the final motorcycle events of the summer to get those who support us in front of other registered voters.

This is a viable and attainable goal. Especially when you consider that the US Census estimates that there are roughly six and half million state residents. Twenty-three percent of those were under the legal age to vote. That represents just shy of five million eligible voters.

The Secretary of State reports that there are 3,882,129 registered voters in TN. Practically speaking, that means roughly four out of five Tennessee residents are registered to vote!

With 12 incumbent upsets in the primaries, 19 open seats and six of those totaling almost 20% of the Senate alone, the 2010 redistricting has already proven to be extremely unpredictable. This 2012 Election year will truly conclude as remarkable as it has opened. What personal relevance will you have to share in that making of history?

What have YOU done for YOU lately?






