YOUR RIGHTS YOUR RIDE



A new session will be starting on the hill before you know it and we will be needing dedicated souls to work on the lobby team. We will need two registered lobbyists and at least six other volunteers. We need to hear from anyone interested in fighting on the front lines. Shoot me an email if this is you.

While you are talking to candidates you might want to mention the fact that the State is looking at raising gas taxes and taxing internet sales. Ask them why the finance committees rejected a bill that could have brought millions of out of State dollars into Tennessee and wouldn't have cost us anything. It takes a sorry son

of a bitch to turn down free money and then turn right around and raise our taxes.

We will be running the same helmet bill we ran last time around, but we do need to hear what other concerns you might have that we might be able to do something about. Again, shoot me an email if you have any ideas. For those interested, lane splitting is not dead, but we are working a better bill to fit the needs of our State. We are looking at a "Black Box" bill.

We will have a legislative retreat after the next BOD. I do not want to have a definite date set until we know who will be Legislative Director. My thoughts are early October at Fall Creek Falls State Park.



We know we need more members across the State and we need a greater diversity of motorcyclists within the organization. We need to encourage and mentor new members and charters rather than start off by telling them what they can and can't do. Just because something didn't work a hundred years ago, doesn't mean it won't work now. I have heard a lot of good ideas coming from some of these younger riders across the State. When we don't take time to listen to them, we are the ones losing out. They can use our experience and wisdom, but they sure as hell don't need our bitterness.

So much for my random thoughts. If you would like to host a legislative meeting in your area, be sure and contact me to arrange a time and location.
