

### To the Hill!!!

The Legislative Committee met on June 9<sup>th</sup> to wrap up the 107<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session. The full explanation was shared of the "who, why & what" the heck happened in the final moments of our Liberty Bill this year. For the sake of this organization's future lobby, much of that discussion can not be put in print.

This led us into a broader discussion of this summer's campaign elections. We discussed enormous opportunities available to be a grass roots activist in order to improve our legislative efforts next year.

There are 13 open House member seats up for grabs and a whopping 6 in the Senate. With 33 Senate member seats, that is a gigantic percentage. Two of these open Senate seats have one of our Champion House members running to fill them: Representative Nicely and Representative Hensley.

We all agreed that as a united body, our critical path should remain focused as follows: To be a *positive* and *professional* influence in the 2012 Campaign Elections.

This means that we should not participate in negative campaigning of those candidates who actively opposed our bill. We should rather participate in lifting candidates up who are running against our opposition.

We also agreed that the Legislative Committee will default candidate selection to be determined at the charter level where we have feet on the ground. This means if you have not brought yourself up to par on who is running and who will support our causes, your committee is still waiting to hear from you. Valuable time and our ability to positively influence elections are ticking away.

We also addressed the rules we must follow according to our Articles of Incorporation as a 501(c)4. With that said, it is extremely important that every member realize that this organization <u>does not endorse</u> any candidate. We briefly discussed the value in a PAC which is able to endorse candidates. Surely the presence of a motorcycle interest PAC in the last three states to win liberty did no harm in their obtaining victory.

But even though CMT/ABATE, Inc does not endorse any candidate, this does not shackle YOU, the constituent, from endorsing a candidate.

CMT/ABATE, Inc is to serve as information officers to the voting motorcyclists in our areas of influence and that is our chief goal this summer. We also need to be an organization who's every move must first consider the unintended consequences that could come back to bite us in the 108<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session.

We finalized our day with a division of state Districts for our Regional Legislative Coordinators (RLC). Every Charter has now been assigned an RLC to help in any coordination efforts to gather information on candidates.

But time is running out! Voter registration deadline for the August 2, 2012 Primaries ends July 3<sup>rd</sup> and early voting for primaries opens July 13<sup>th</sup>.

All of this information will have arrived to you before the printing of this newsletter. If you have failed to receive it, PLEASE call me. Your Legislative Team is counting on your grass roots activism help with our causes in next year's Legislative lobby.

Working campaigns counts as 'acts of constituency' towards the merit patch. But your team must be informed of your work to know you are getting out there and making a positive influence for all motorcyclists.

After the Board meeting update, I recognized several members for their outstanding, above and beyond hard work this past session. Those members or their charter reps were presented with a patch for their efforts. These valuable team participants represent the charters of TN Valley, N.E., Knoxville, D/H/H, Stones River, Sumner, UC, Nashville and At-large. These individuals are listed by name with a photograph of the patch they were awarded.

All of these individuals have multiple 'x' marks on the Patch Incentive chart. They all were available 'on call' as the need arose to enlist motorcycle constituents to participate in lobbying their members. They understand that this organization stands for much more than the next good ride or event.

We are Patriots. We ride and we VOTE!



Meeting started at 7:01 Minutes read and approved Membership includes 5 members and 3 visitors



The Look Twice Save a Life Signs were approved by the city of Eagleville. We continue to work on approval from Smyrna and Lavergne.


The director, Teresa, passed out slips of paper for others to read regarding what CMT/ABATE is and the goals of the organization.
